Unique Pelly River Canoe trip with day hikes along the South Canol Road

We offer you a very special adventure. In Faro we are putting the canoes in the water and we will spend 8 days on the Pelly River. Easy paddling changes itself with simple white water. Through wild, untouched land we paddle past gentle hills, until we reach Pelly Crossing. After a relaxing day at the cabin, we explore the unique region of the South Canol Road on day hikes. You sleep in the cabin or in the wall tent.

Date

- July 6th - 20th, 2011

Course

- 07/06 Arrival in Whitehorse. We accompany you doing the groceries. Then we drive south on the Alaska Highway towards the South Canol Road where we arrive about 1.5 hours later.
- 07/07 We get the drinking water from the nearby creek. An outhouse as well as your own fire pit belongs to the cabin. You cook your own meals on a propane stove. The accommodation neither has power nor running water. We learn all about the material and equipment we use on the canoe trip (GPS, Satellite phone, eSpot). On our nearby lake we repeat our paddling skills. There is always enough time to catch a nice rainbow trout and barbeque the fish on the fire right away.
- 07/08 After a spectacular drive through the mountains along the South Canol Road we reach the campground at Faro and we stay there for the first night in our tents.
- 07/09 The canoe tour starts. The Pelly River has some white water and rapids. There are several spots, which require your highest attention. The Pelly River valley is wide open and we enjoy great views.
- 07/10 –
- 07/15 As an average we paddle about 5 to 7 hours per day. A well physical condition is therefore required. Our camping spots along the river often spoil us with beautiful views and also when we sit around the campfire in the evening, we have the Pelly just for us.
- 07/16 Around noon we arrive at Pelly Crossing. On the long way back along the Klondike Highway we stop at the famous Five Finger Rapids. Via Braeburn Lodge and Whitehorse we finally reach at late night our cabins on the South Canol Road again.
- 07/17 Today you can do what ever you like. You have time to review the canoe trip and to simply let dangle your soul.
- 07/18-
- 07/19 On day hikes we explore the region along the South Canol Road. The average day tour takes about 4 to 6 hours and we will climb a few hundred meters in elevation. Of course there is the possibility to skip a day hike and to spend the day at the cabin or on the lake.
- 07/20 Transfer to Whitehorse
