## Equipment

In order for a canoe trip in the wilderness to be carried out safely and successfully, you need extensive, first-rate and hard-wearing equipment.

### **The following is put at your disposal and is included in the price:**

- 2 person Canadian canoe
- per canoe 2 paddles, a spare paddle and life jackets
- 2 person tent with Therm-a-Rest and pillow
- per participant 2 water and air tight containers for food, clothes etc. (bear safe)
- if needed an extra water tight canoe bag
- everything necessary for the preparation of the food (cooking pots, plates, cups, cutlery etc.)
- all food and drink (without alcoholic drinks) during the trip (excluding Dawson City and Mayo)
- we guarantee maximum safety. We are therefore equipped with satellite phone, eSport and GPS as well as rescue and first aid equipment.

### **Your own equipment**

- Sleeping bag for summer trips which will keep you warm enough to at least -5 degrees C. In autumn you should bring a sleeping bag which will keep you warm to -15 degrees C.
- underwear
- 2-3 pairs of warm socks
- 1 pair of long johns
- 2 pair of trousers (i.e. with zippers, no jeans)
- 2 functional T-shirt (no cotton because it won't keep you warm if wet and it won't dry fast enough)
- 2 warm fleece-jackets (no cotton because it won't keep you warm if wet and it won't dry fast enough)
- waterproof and breathable rain jacket and trousers (tested under the shower for at least 10 minutes)
- gloves (important)
- hat / sun protection
- insect repellent (available in Whitehorse)
- toiletries / sun cream / individual drug
- knife
- camera / batteries
- flashlight
- hiking boots
- knee pads if you like
- sandals or sneakers
- Yukon fishing licence (available in Whitehorse)
