2 day trial canoe river trip

Trip 1 Big Salmon River

The Big Salmon offers a great and varied river adventure. Frequent tree obstacles, strong currents and high waves characterize the Big Salmon. We launch our canoe at Quiet Lake on the South Canol Road and reach the start of the Big Salmon River via Sandy Lake and Big Salmon Lake.

River description

- lasts a total of 12 days, of which 10 canoe days
- length 240 km plus 120 km on the Yukon River to Little Salmon Village
- degree of difficulty: WW I to III
- canoe experience is required

Trip 3 The leisurely Pelly River

We launch our canoe on the bank of the Pelly River at the village of Faro. A seven day, varied and leisurely river trip awaits us. Easy drifting changes into simple white water. We paddle through wild, untouched land in the direction of Pelly Crossing. The river guides us through peaceful, hilly country. We have lots of time on this trip. Time to enjoy, time for the romance of the campfire and time to forget everyday life.

River description

- lasts a total of 10 days, of which 7 canoe days
- length 330 km to Pelly Crossing
- degree of difficulty: WW I to II
- designed for beginners when low water

Trip 4 Teslin River

This river offers a unique impression of the wilderness combined with a lot of history. The Teslin River does not place any high demands and is ideal for beginners. Before we launch our canoe at Johnson's Crossing, we follow the tempting smell of cinnamon buns which are freshly baked and sold here. In Hootalinqua, the Teslin flows into the Yukon River. Afterwards we set off on this legendary river in the direction of Little Salmon Village. A hundred years ago, thousands of stampedes took the same route. Today, abandoned settlements and log cabins tell the tale of the gold rush. The river tells us this unique story of hope and disappointment. The trip ends shortly before Carmacks at Little Salmon Village.

- length 300 km to Little Salmon Village
- degree of difficulty: WW I
- designed for beginners
